

## Novo Nordisk Foundation Innovation initiatives



**Education and Fellowships Programmes** are designed to make education on innovation and entrepreneurship available to students and researchers. Initiatives include the Master's Programme CBS-Bio, the successful internship programme MISTI MIT, the International Bioinnovation Scholarship programme, the BioMedical Design Fellowship programme and the postgraduate program for academic disciplines, School of Health Innovation.



**The NNF Innovation Grants** seek to accelerate commercialisation of research findings and the development of novel solutions and technologies in the Nordics. The Pioneer Innovator and Distinguished Innovator grants are awarded in open competition. Both support application-oriented research and evaluation of ideas with commercial potential on a bi-annual basis.



**Open Innovation** Initiatives give support to researchers from the idea generation stage and enable collaboration with industry. Initiatives include Open Discovery Innovation Network (ODIN) that facilitates industry-relevant collaboration focusing on drug discovery and diagnosis. The Plant2Food platform aims to help accelerate the transition to a more plant-based human diet. Additionally, the mission-driven CO<sub>2</sub> Research Centre (CORC) is developing knowledge and technology that can be used to capture and recycle carbon dioxide.



Acceleration and mentoring initiatives provide support to innovative researchers and start-ups. These initiatives include acceleration through BioInnovation Institute Foundation (BII) including DIANA, which focuses on accelerating Quantum start-ups. Beta.Health drives innovation within the clinical environment at hospitals. Nordic Mentoring Network (NOME) and SPARK Denmark are some of the initiatives providing mentoring for projects by seasoned business and industry experts.



**Through matchmaking and events,** NNF has created opportunities to connect researchers with potential collaborators, customers, or investors. Initiatives include national competitions at student-level (UNLEASH, iGEM), as well as the Nordic Innovation Fair and TechBBQ where researchers and international investors can connect through engaging talks, pitch-sessions and showcasing as well as share knowledge in the startup ecosystem.



**Legal** regulation overall, and intellectual property law in particular, are central to the business models of life-science companies. Inter-CeBIL provides crucial new insights into the complex mechanisms and legal frameworks that drive the biomedical innovation system.
