



Novo Nordisk Foundation Postdoctoral Fellowships for Research Abroad

Why apply?

These fellowships provide a unique opportunity to conduct research at top research institutions abroad. The fellowships last 4 years: At least 3 years must be spent abroad, and the last year can then be spent on returning and establishing yourself at a Danish research institution. Throughout the fellowship you will be employed by a Danish research institution with a Danish salary.

You may apply for up to DKK 1 million per year to cover your own salary, project-related expenses, travel and insurance expenses and certain extra costs associated with the stay and potentially bringing your family abroad.

What types of research?

You can apply for a postdoctoral fellowship within the overall research area 'bioscience and basic biomedicine' with a project relevant for understanding the human organism and/or basal mechanisms underlying health and disease.

Where can you go?

You can go to any excellent research institution abroad, that is relevant for your project and the development of your unique research profile.

Who may apply?

All relevant PhD graduates with ties to Denmark and a Danish research institution may apply. At the time of application, you can be completing your PhD programme, have started a postdoctoral fellowship in Denmark or maybe even abroad.

How do you apply?

You can apply annually, typically between November and January. Before you apply, you should have:

- An agreement with a Danish research institution to employ you and manage your potential grant
- An agreement with a research institution abroad to host you
- A project and a plan
